### 03 Nights / 04 Days – Delhi @ Amritsar –

Day – 01	Bengaluru / Delhi	By air

Morning Transfer from hotel to airport to catch flight for Delhi. IC 505–0930 / 1200 hrs.

Upon arrival in Delhi transfer and check-in at hotel.

India's capital and a major gateway to the country, contemporary Delhi is a bustling metropolis, which successfully combines in its folds - the ancient with the modern. Amidst the fast spiral skyscrapers the remnants of a bygone time in the form of its many monuments stand as silent reminders to the region's ancient legacy. The first impressions for any visitor travelling in from the airport are of a spacious, garden city, tree-lined with a number of beautiful parks.

Evening proceed for sound and light show at Red Fort.

Breakfast at hotel.

Proceed for full day **City tour of Delhi**, which reflects the legacy the British left behind.

The tour to Delhi will include a visit to the **Qutab Minar**, the tallest stone tower in India. Qutub-ud-din Aibak started construction in 1199. Pulling down 27 Hindu and Jain temples and using their columns erected the attached Quwwat-ul-Islam mosque. Then visit **Humayun's tomb**, built by the widow of the second Mughal Emperor, Humayun, it is an outstanding monument in the Indo-Persian style, a precursor of the Taj Mahal. Visit to Old Delhi will include visit to the Jama Masjid and walk upto Chandni Chowk, the famous by lanes of Old Delhi and drive past Red Fort. The tour also includes a drive past with photo opportunity of the imposing **India Gate**, the **Parliament building** and the **Rastrapati Bhawan**, the President's residence.

Day – 03	Delhi / Amritsar	By Train

Check out of hotel and transfer to New Delhi Station to board the Shatabdi Express train for Amritsar at 0720 hrs and arrive Amritsar at 1325 hrs.

**Amritsar** is one of the most ancient and fascinating cities of India. It is an important **seat of Sikh history** and culture. Being the gateway for travellers coming to India on the overland route from central Asia it later became the centre of various commercial activities. Amritsar has various historical and religious sites. The most famous of them all in the Golden Temple which was founded by the fourth Sikh Guru Ramdas and completed by his successor Guru Arjan Dev.

On arrival check-in at the hotel

Evening **Excursion to Wagah border**, "The final frontier", about 28 Kms from Amritsar. It's an interesting experience especially at sunset when the 'Beating the Retreat' ceremony takes place with the Border Gurads on the both sides. The changing of the guards and the ceremonial lowering of the flags ceremony is carried out with great pomp.

**Day – 04**

**Amritsar / Delhi**

**By Train**

After buffet breakfast at the hotel proceed for **sightseeing tour of Amritsar** visiting **Golden temple** and **Jallianwala Bagh**.

Certainly, the first look brings onto the innocent eye the image of a transcendent fact, in which the shrine stands makes for ecstatic awareness. A mud-house was constructed by Guru Amar Das in the beginning. The Amrit Sarovar remained a village tank, until the fourth Guru Ram Das began to carry out the plans of his mentor for a more permanent structure in brick.



Continue the visit to **Jallianwala Bagh** - the historic site where hundreds of innocent Indian men, women and children were massacred by British General Michael Dyer on April 13, 1919. A memorial and Garden has been created as a national monument.

Later in the evening transfer to Amritsar Train Station to board train for Delhi departing by Shatabdi Express from Amritsar at 1700 hrs and arriving New Delhi at 2300 hrs .

Upon arrival in New Delhi transfer to airport for onward journey
